

Guide to Leavers 2013-17 and Qualifications within Numeracy

Since we introduced Functional Skills at Beaucroft in September 2013.

What about the two students that were unable to pass Functional Skills?

Both students accessed Beaucroft Post 16 where they have worked towards a Diploma in Life Skills Entry 1. This course has several Numeracy elements which are Money, Timetables within travel, measuring in cooking and Time.

What about students that are unable to access Functional Skills?

There is a growing minority of students that due to their learning difficulties are unable to access Functional Skills. This has been recognised by all involved and therefore these students now access Personal Progress which is a qualification through ASDAN. This year we have had seven, Year 11 students completing Numeracy units towards their certification. All have passed. The majority of these students currently will go on to Beaucroft Post 16 where they will continue to develop their Numeracy in the Diploma in Life Skills as well as having the option to take formal qualifications within Functional Skills.

Leavers 2016-17

We have had **15** Year 11 leavers in this year.
