

14-16 Curriculum Pathways at Beaucroft

Accreditation

Personal Social Development is an ASDAN qualification with 3 levels of access. Personal Progress (ASDAN) is another pathway to lifeskills accreditation.

Functional Skills qualifications are delivered at 4 levels in 2 subjects. English and Maths are (OCR/EDEXCEL respectively) qualifications assessed at Entry Levels 1,2, 3 and Level 1.

Senior Options

Senior options run every Friday morning and are an opportunity for students to select an aspect of their curriculum. Options this year include:

Dance/drama (Dance teacher)

Cookery Club (Let's Get Cooking group)

Film Club (delivered by KidsCameraAction)

Personalised Curriculum

There are a number of focus groups and external agencies that provide specialised support to meet individual need. These include CAMHS (mental health), Educational Psychologist Service, Occupational Therapy and Speech and Language. Small focus groups include Socially Speaking (communication) and Girls Allowed (social group that incorporate PSHE elements).

There are also individual and group inclusion opportunities at local mainstream schools.

Enrichment Opportunities

Inclusion Links: For example music/drama workshops with QE. Residentials. A vital aspect of our lifeskills programme. Annual Centre Parcs trip.

Canford and Bryanston Drama and Dance. Senior groups enjoy weekly drama and dance sessions off site led by A level drama students.

Drumming. Delivered by external drumming teacher.

Youth Club. Available on Wednesdays after school as part of extended services.

Independent Travel Training

Travel training is a crucial element of our lifeskills programme. Students are provided regular opportunities to practice safe travel as a pedestrian and on public transport (bus and train). This includes planning a journey and money handling. Some students receive individual training on specific routes, for example home to college.
