You can also use a tally chart to total up how many items you found:

Bicycles	/	1
Chairs	////	4

We had a lot of daisies in our garden which made it a bit tricky to count them all so we put a hula hoop over a section in our garden and counted the daisies in the hoop. You can do this for smaller objects too.

This, of course, can be done inside your house or you could take your clipboard out with you when you go for a walk. Here are some things you could find on your walk:

- Signposts
- Road name signs
- Dogs
- Cats
- Cars
- Street lights
- Bumble bees

You could also search for things that require a bit more of a thoughtful input:
