You can make your own cakes and serve drinks. Have a look through the cupboard and make your own menu of items to choose from in your café. →

← We chose to price our items at under 10p each so that we could use 1p coins – that way, it doesn't get too confusing when counting what each coin is worth. If your child is more advanced in counting or using money, change up the prices to practice using different coins!
