HOW TO MAKE A GRASS CATERPILLAR



You will need:

- Old pair of tights
- Compost
- Grass Seeds
- Eyes (googly eyes/milk tops etc)
- Antennae (pipe cleaners etc)



Instructions:

1. Cut off one of the legs from the tights.





2. Put some compost in a bucket and add some grass seeds then give it a good stir.







3. Open up the end of the tight and start filling with the compost and grass seeds mixture (this is easier if someone opens out the end of the tight while you fill it!)





4. When the tight is as full as you want it then tie a knot in the end and cut off the excess.



5. Decorate the face of your caterpillar by adding eyes and antennae. We used a pipe cleaner for the antennae and googly eyes (we used a milk bottle top with a nail through then glued on the eye then stuck it into our caterpillar! You can glue/stick or use another method if you like.)







6. Water your caterpillar and watch it grow!
