






 You  will  need:


String

 food colouring /  liquid  watercolours


paper


scissors

 small  bowls /  cups

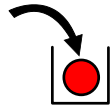
 ruler  (optional)  Glove  (optional)

cups.



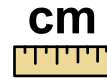
Cut

the



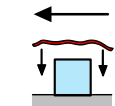
string

into the

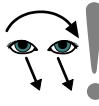


food colouring

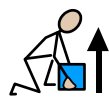
until it is completely

carefully

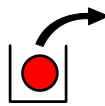



Now  place the  string onto one half of the  paper, making  swirly  patterns. 






Make sure you  leave an end of the string  hanging out  one edge of the 





 paper. You can  use  as many  pieces as you  like.



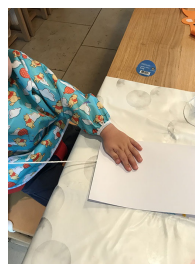
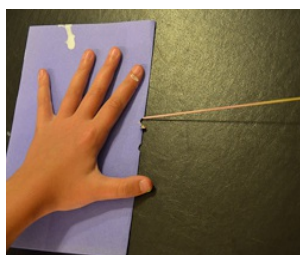
Now  fold the  paper over the  string.






 Put something  heavy  on top the  paper. (or you can  use  your  hand.)

 Holding onto the  heavy object with  one hand  gently  pull the

 end of the string with the other  hand, until the  string has  completely

 come out.



Now  remove the  heavy item and  unfold the  paper. You  should now have

 a work of art.
