What we have learnt from the past year and moving forward

When we as a school decided we wished every pupil to leave with a mathematical qualification, in 2013, every student bar 2 have achieved this. The two students in question were part of the driving force in introducing Personal Progress as the clientele at Beacroft became increasingly complex. Both students accessed Beacroft Post 16 where they worked towards a Diploma in Life Skills Entry 1. This course had several Numeracy elements which were Money, Timetables within travel, measuring in cooking and Time.

Over the last 8 years, an increasing number of students have accessed their Mathematics through Personal Progress to the point this year where, for the first time, more students have achieved this qualification over Functional Skills. Mathematics has therefore, in some senior classes, resulted in targeted group work of each student pathway.

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
